 - d. Course provider certificate.
2. The Course Provider agrees to comply with the terms and conditions set out in the Alberta Food Safety Education Guidelines (the "Application Package").
3. If the Course Provider proposes any changes to course materials or content, course delivery or instructor qualifications, the Course Provider shall submit the proposed changes to Alberta Health for review and approval prior to implementation.
4. Alberta Health reserves the right to modify the terms and conditions for recognition under section 31 of the *Food Regulation*. The Course Provider shall update its course materials accordingly and shall ensure that instructors understand and apply any changes.
5. The Course Provider agrees to allow a representative of Alberta Health to monitor its course offerings, monitor training, review course materials, review the qualifications of

course instructors, and access any other information from the Course Provider that Alberta Health reasonably requires to assess the Courses.

Recognition of the Course may be revoked at any time if the terms and conditions of this letter and the Application Guidelines are not followed.

It is the responsibility of the Course Provider to ensure that requisite approvals have been obtained for use in the Course for any material that is subject to copyright and trade mark laws.
